RAINY DAY /STORM PLAN  
Students in Portable Classrooms  
Effective August 24, 2015

**Pre-Kindergarten / VPK**

1. **Rainy Days that cause an adverse walking condition for students (without a serious storm threat) at dismissal**  
The gate at the playground will be opened by a staff member. Parents will go to the classroom door and check-out their students at the classroom.
2. **Rainy Day with storm threat**  
Students will be housed inside the building. VPK will be in Room 109 and all other Pre-K will be in Room 107. Parents will meet staff at single exit door leading to the parking lot to enter building to check-out students.

**Elementary Students**

3. **Rainy Days that cause an adverse walking condition for students (without a serious storm threat) at dismissal**
  - a. The radar will be monitored and students will move inside to a designated partner (TBD) as needed for co-teach instruction.
  - b. If this occurs very close to dismissal, the classes will move to the cafeteria.
4. **Rainy Day with storm threat**  
Students will be housed inside the building paired with a co-teach partner.

LUNCH PLAN ON RAINY / STORMY DAYS  
Students in Portable Classrooms  
Effective September 8, 2014

**Pre-Kindergarten / Elementary Students**

1. **Rainy Days that cause an adverse walking condition for students (without a serious storm threat) at lunch**
  - a. The radar will be watched and students will eat earlier or later depending on the weather. (preferred)
  - b. Lunch will be prepared by the Lunchroom Manager and his staff and sent to the classrooms.
2. **Rainy Day with storm threat at lunch**
  - a. Students will eat as close to their normal time since they will be housed inside the building.
