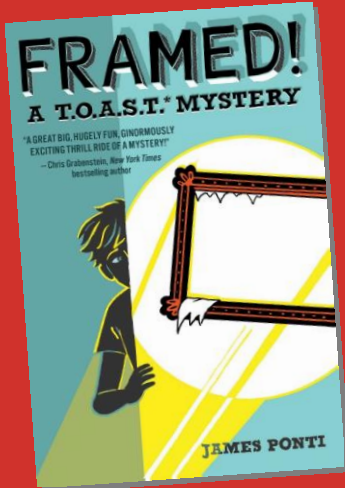


# Osceola School District's Summer Book Club
